#### Equipment

- Please can all children bring their named P.E kits into school on a Monday and keep them in all week. This should include a pair of indoor shoes and outdoor shoes.
- Due to lack of space in our cloak-room areas we ask that only small bags are used.
- Pencil cases are not necessary as we have all the equipment needed in school.
- Please can you provide your child with a named painting apron. (This can be an old shirt or top to protect school uniform.)

### **Assessment**

The children have been completing some baseline assessments to assess their understanding of a variety of subject areas.

These will continue over the course of the next couple of weeks. This assessment will be used to inform any areas of learning which need additional focus.

Further information regarding intervention groups will follow.

## Reading

The children will be using the accelerated reader scheme. At the beginning of the term, they will complete a Star Reader assessment. This will give them a ZPD from which to choose an appropriate book.

We also want our pupils to have an appropriate level of challenge so this year, for the first time, we are using reading targets which are linked to Accelerated Reader. This 'points target' is personalised to your child and is linked to their reading ability. When your child has read a book, they are able to complete a quiz and this allows them to earn points. There will be more information sent out about this in the next few weeks.

#### Home Support

- Reading- We would like the children to read at least 5 times a week.
   They have a reading record for you or your child to make any comments about their reading.
- Reading Challenge In order to further motivate children to read at home we are introducing a class 'home reading reward table.' Initially this will focus upon encouraging children to read at least five times a week. We ask that at least three of these are with an adult, who then signs the reading record.
- On a Friday the children will be asked to hand in their reading record. If there is evidence of five separate instances of individual reading (with three parent/adult comments in reading record) the children will gain a sticker for their reading. This will go onto our class reading chart to move towards a reading reward over the course of the academic year.

### Spellings

- Spellings- Each week your child will be set a new spelling list to learn. They will be expected to apply their spellings to their class work. They will be tested on their spelling list on a Wednesday. Some of the spellings the children will have, may have already previously been given. This is because they are expected to know the spellings from the Year 3 and 4 list set by the government at the end of the year. The new spellings will go home on a.
- Soon, your child will be taking home a list of spellings which they have been tested
  on. The highlighted ones are those which were correct. Please support your child
  in learning the ones that they have difficulty in spelling. They will be tested on the
  list again next term so they can see the progress they have made.

#### Multiplication Tables


- Each Friday your child will be tested on the multiplication tables we
  have been learning in class. Please support your child by working
  alongside them to practice these tables.
- The children will be using the times tables Rockstars resource and will have their own individual login so that they can access this at home.

#### Regular Homework

 Homework - The children will receive a piece of homework to complete over a 2 week period. This will be linked to English, Maths or one of the themes we are learning about.

#### Rules/Rewards and Sanctions

- All children have been told the school rules and expectations of behaviour in Upper Phase. Rules, rewards and sanctions are displayed in all classrooms.
- Children have the opportunity to earn Class Dojo points and merits through excellent learning and behaviour choices.
