We have 3 classes in Reception. Each class is staffed by a teacher, a full time Learning Support Assistant and a Midday Supervisor Assistant.

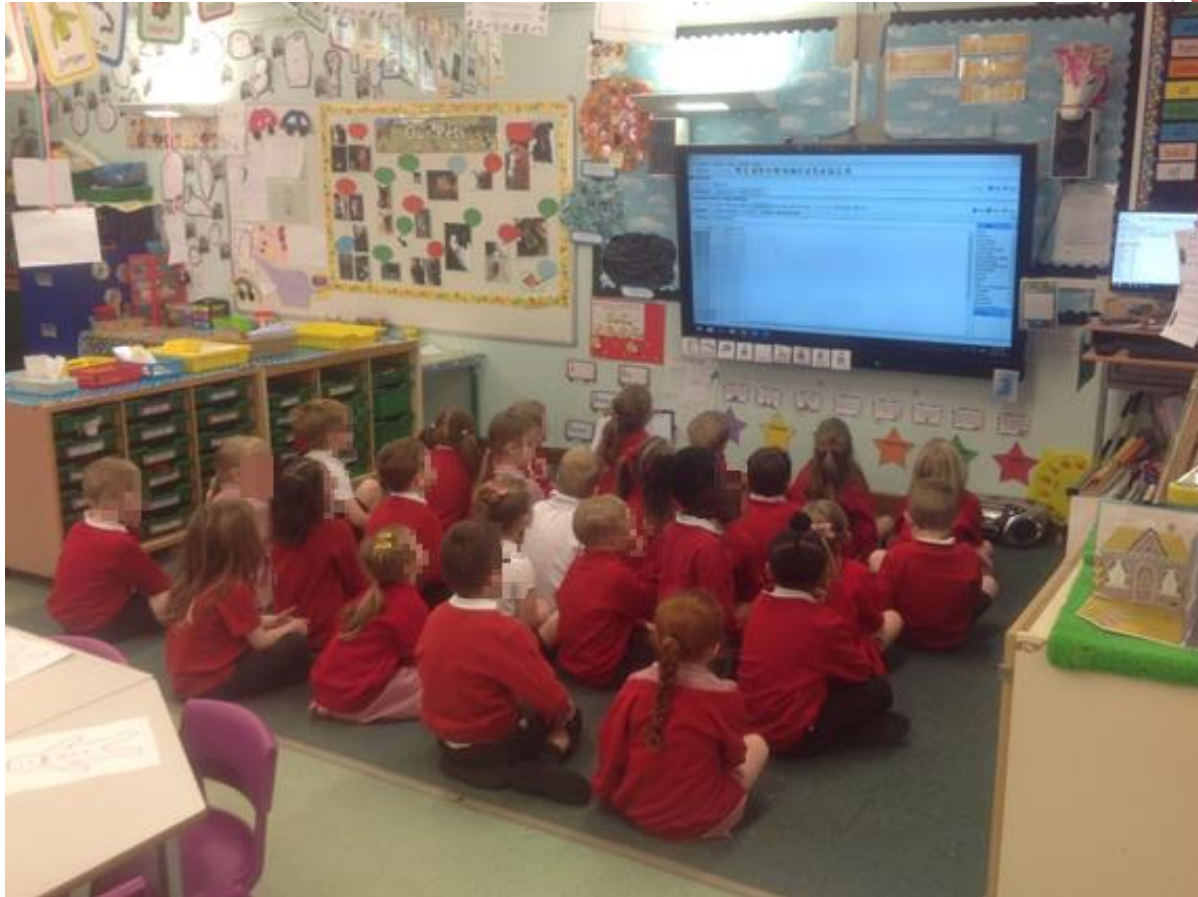

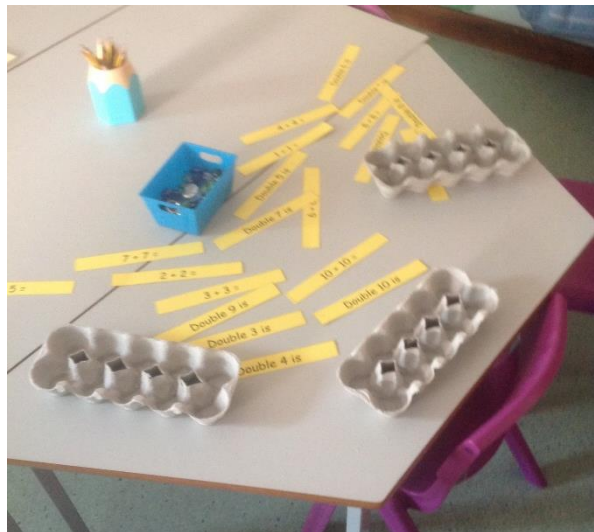
Carpet time

What can you do to help your child's learning when they begin school?

- ▶ Encouraging independence in changing clothing
- ▶ Encouraging independence in toileting
- ▶ Sharing books together frequently, talking about the pictures
- ▶ Share the school reading book, make comments in their reading diary
- ▶ Encourage mark making, shopping lists, name writing etc
- ▶ Practise counting at any time, climbing the stairs, shopping etc
- ▶ Play simple board games
- ▶ Sing number rhymes and songs together
- ▶ Support any work that comes home: ie sounds and number work

Uniform

- ▶ Sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo.
- ▶ It is recommended for all children to have a set of spare labelled clothes and extra underwear kept in school at all times.
- ▶ Please ensure that names are in everything! Including school shoes.
- ▶ Send coats where appropriate
- ▶ Sensible shoes
- ▶ No jewellery please
- ▶ A labelled school P.E. kit and a labelled PE bag
- ▶ A school book bag (with only one **small** keyring attached)
