Play time - the reception children have their own area of the playground.




They have their own climbing frame and climbing wall.








What can you do to help your child's learning when they begin school?

- Encouraging independence in changing clothing
- Encouraging independence in toileting
- Sharing books together frequently, talking about the pictures
- Share the school reading book, make comments in their reading diary
- Encourage mark making, shopping lists, name writing etc
- Practise counting at any time, climbing the stairs, shopping etc
- Play simple board games
- Sing number rhymes and songs together
- Support any work that comes home: ie sounds and number work
